

STARTING OF HOME NURSING CARE AND NANNY CARE TRAINING COURSE AT BAL BHAWAN, MOHALI.

The Council is conducting a Home Nursing Care & Nanny Care Training Course. The duration of the course is 6 months. After the completion of the course, the student will be eligible for job of Home Nursing Care in our Country & in foreign countries as well. Under this training, the student will also be given training about the care of disabled & ailing person. This course will provide opportunity to serve the mankind and also provide self employment to the trainees.



Nanny Care – Under this component of Nanny Care, the students (male/female) will be given Training to look after the children in the age group of 6 months to 6 years, to provide them nutrition, take care of their cleanliness & hygiene & to provide the pre-school education. The parents of children who want to avail this facility may contact them & they can provide care to such children by opening creche centres under self employment.

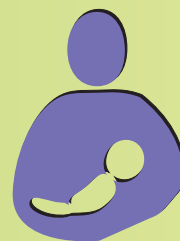

STATE LEVEL BAL BHAWAN AT SAS NAGAR (MOHALI)

Bal Bhawan was constructed in 2002 by the Punjab Council from its own resources @ cost of Rs. 1.06 Crore where in presently following activities are carried out :-

1. Computer Centre
2. Library
3. Hobby Classes
4. Creche-cum-playway centre
5. Summer camp
6. Nanny Care and Home Nursing Care Training course.

VANI INTEGRATED SCHOOL FOR THE HEARING IMPAIRED

The Council is running a School called "Vani Integrated School for Hearing Impaired" at Patiala since 2006. The building was constructed by the Council from its own resources @ cost of Rs. 55 Lakhs. The school is running from Nursery to 10th class. Children are imparted education on Punjab School Education Board pattern by the trained staff. Presently 250 children are studying in the school, of which around 50 children are hearing impaired, slow learners and Autistic. A project namely "Integrated Development and Rehabilitation of Children with Special Needs" was sanctioned and implemented for children of Vani School. A grant of Rs. 9,89,000/- was sanctioned by the National Child Fund, Govt. of India.

BRAVERY AWARDS

The applications of children who have done some act of bravery in the

State of Punjab are forwarded to the ICCW, New Delhi by the Council for National Bravery Awards.

INTEGRATED CHILD DEVELOPMENT SCHEME

The Child Welfare Council, Punjab has been allotted three ICDS Blocks by the State Government of Punjab namely Bathinda, Sidhwan Bet and Tarsikka for administration. While Bathinda Block started functioning in April, 1994, the other two blocks were made operational in March, 1997. The expenditure on these projects is met out of the grant-in-aid sanctioned by Govt of India and released through the State Govt. for administering these blocks.

CRECHE CENTRES

Child Welfare Council, Punjab is providing early childhood care through the Creche Programme. The Council is running three model creches Creche Centers i.e. Central Jail, Gurdaspur, Bal Bhawan, Gurdaspur, Bal Bhawan, Mohali.

SCRUTINY FOR ADOPTION

The Child Welfare Council, Punjab is functioning as a scrutinizing agency for guardianship and adoption work as authorized by ICCW, New Delhi. Officers of Child Welfare Council including the Secretary has been attending the Court as and when there is requirement by the Court.
