A Brief Note About the Working of Child Welfare Council, Punjab

Child Welfare Council, Punjab is registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 on 6th March 1962. Hon. Governor of Punjab is the President of the Council by virtue of his status and Wife of the Governor is the Vice-President of Child Welfare Council, Punjab. The management and day to day affaires of the Council are being looked after by its office bearers and members of Executive Committee.

It is worth mentioning here that the Council has its branches i.e. District Child Welfare Councils with Deputy Commissioner as President and wife of DC as Chairperson. Besides there are a few active social workers and activists who are involved in the implementation of various programmes of the Council.

The Child Welfare Council, Punjab is running various projects for the welfare of children especially border/remote areas like Tarsikka, Ferozepur, Gurdaspur by focussing on Evening Schools for poor and deprived children in the State of Punjab i.e.
